

Work Instruction for: In-take Protocols

Note: this is the procedure to follow for in-take of cat and kittens outside of clinic time or when in-take is done on clinic day

Start Health Chart

- 1. Complete the top information. In-take location means the community where the cat is from. If you cannot estimate date of birth, leave blank.
- 2. Weigh kittens and record weight
- 3. Look over for anything obvious such as fleas, ear mites and ringworm. If suffering from URI, start on medication.

Consult with medical coordinator or vet if ringworm, URI or other medical conditions are observed. See posted Cage Set-Up Protocols.

- 4. Administer the following if not going through clinic that day:
 - Pyrantel pamoate / Strongid de-wormer on any cat or kitten over 1 lb.
 Use a clean syringe for each cat and give orally. Dosage is posted.

Note: cats or kittens going through clinic that same day will get wormed the day following clinic.

First FVRCP vaccine on any cat or kitten over 1 ½ lb. Do ½ vaccine for kittens between 1 ½ - 2 ½ lbs. Save vaccine bottle with the lot code label. Note: if kittens are under 12 oz do not vaccinate mamma kitty.

Cats and kittens coming in on their day of surgery will be vaccinated while under anesthesia.

 Revolution on any cat and kittens over 1 ½ lbs. Dose is in Revolution drawer. Kittens with fleas may be bathed at sink using the DeFlea Shampoo.
